



Notice of Funding Availability & Request for Proposals

Community Services Block Grant Program FFY 2019

The Yellowstone Country Assistance Network, Park County Tripartite Board is accepting applications for funding under the FY 2019 Community Services Block Grant [CSBG] Program, authorized under Public Law 97-35[Section 675(c) and (4)]. CSBG program funds in the amount to be determined by the Wyoming Community Services Program and are available on a competitive application process to community-based organizations operating within Park County to improve the conditions of poverty.

Projects will be scored based upon the top five (5) needs identified by low-income Park County residents in the 2016 Park County Low Income Needs Assessment found on our website ycanwyoming.com.

CSBG Requirements:

1. ALL CSBG grantee and subgrantee agencies must use CAP60 database program to capture their data and inputting clients into the system.
2. ALL CSBG grantee and subgrantee agencies trained in ROMA. If your agency is not you may budget an in-state-travel for two staff members to attend ROMA training.
3. ALL CSBG grantee and subgrantee agencies must submit a community action plan with their application. As long as the tables are completed and the other three areas are addressed, then the plan will be acceptable.
4. If awarded a contract, the agency shall have an accounting manual that describes its financial procedures in sufficient detail to allow reasonable understanding of financial practices and adhere to IRS and OMB 209 Uniform Guidance.
 - a. The agency must also provide a written cost allocation plan and provide documentation of all expenditures allocated to this program before reimbursements will be issued.

Services/Programs funded with FY 2019 CSBG funds may be provided only to eligible residents of Park County (families and individuals with household incomes that do not exceed 125% of the federal poverty level) during the period October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.
